Summary Rules for Shoe Your Support Competition 2018

(For complete rules refer to www.alzheimersfamily.org)

Submitting Shoes: Contestants may submit a pair of shoes or a single shoe decorated in any style they choose. Any type of shoe may be used. Submissions are not required to be new shoes, but Contestants should avoid used shoes that are in an unsanitary condition. Ornaments, appliques, sequins, ribbons, and other applied objects used to decorate the shoe(s) must be firmly attached. Sewing, strong glue, and mechanical fasteners may be used. Tape is not acceptable as a fastener.

Where to Submit Shoes: Shoes may be delivered to the Florida Artists Gallery, 8219 Orange Avenue, in Floral City between September 1, 2018 and the close of business October 15, 2018. (Check Florida Artists Gallery web site or Facebook page to identify the hours the Gallery is open); or to the Citrus County Chronicle, 1624 N. Meadowcrest Blvd., Crystal River, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Contestants unable to deliver shoes to the Florida Artists Gallery or the Citrus County Chronicle may call the Alzheimer's Family Organization at 352-616-0170 to make alternative arrangements.

Competition Classes: Any individual of any age or gender is eligible to participate in the Competition, as are corporations, community groups, churches, and independent foundations. There shall be five Classes of competition: 1) Elementary School – age 11 and under; 2) Middle School – ages 11 through 13; 3) High School – ages 14 through 18. 4) Adult – over the age of 18; 5) Group – any corporation, community group, church, etc.

Entry Procedure and Fees: Contestants must fill out an official entry form (available at the Florida Artists Gallery, the Citrus County Chronicle, or on the AFO web site) and pay an entry fee of \$10 per entry (no fee will be charged for children under 11). Entry fees may be paid by cash, checks made out to the AFO, or on line at www.alzheimersfamily.org. Credit or debit cards are not accepted. If entry fee has been submitted through the AFO web site, the contestant must include a printed verification with his or her submission when delivering shoes to the Florida Artists Gallery or the Citrus County Chronicle.

Live Judging: All Submissions will be placed on public display in Floral City on the morning of October 20, 2018. A "People's Choice" fund-raising judging will be conducted whereby individuals may buy tickets to use for voting. Tickets must be deposited no later than 10 a.m. October 20, 2018. Shoes arriving at the Community Building in Floral City subsequent to noon, October 19, 2018, may be displayed but will not be eligible for judging.

On-Line Judging: There will also be on-line judging for The Chronicle Reader's Choice Award www.chronicleonline.com/contests at a fee of \$1.00 per vote, which is payable on line. Only submissions received prior to the close of business October 18, 2018 will be eligible for the Chronicle Reader's Choice Award.

Awards: Awards for First, Second, and Third places in each Class will be announced at Citrus County Walk Aware for Alzheimer's at noon on October 20, 2018. Medals will be awarded to three places in each of the five classes. In the case of ties, equal awards will be made to each party in the tie. In addition, a Chronicle People's Choice Award will be published in the Citrus County Chronicle.
